Haverstraw, N.Y. July 11th – A full day of free music and art set against the backdrop of the breathtaking Hudson – that's what the 2nd annual Haverstraw RiverArts & Music Festival promises. On Saturday, July 11th from 12pm – 6pm, Emeline Park (16 Front Street, Haverstraw) plays host to 4 National and local bands: Jamie Block (Folk), Pablo Mayor Folklore Urbano (Modern Colombian groove), Mr. Breakdown (Rhythm & funk) and Jawbone (Americana), and professional artists creating sculptures on-site from brick, clay and stone. Other highlights of this community and river-centric event are Mario the Magician headlining kid's entertainment, face painting, one-of-a kind crafts by Hudson Valley crafters and the best food trucks. As part of the celebration of the mighty Hudson River and its waterfront villages, environmental education will be presented alongside a guided history walk (in partnership with Keep Rockland Beautiful) that tells the story of "Bricktown", the brickmaking capitol of the US.
